

VISAS FOR NEPAL

Welcome and congratulations on reserving your spot in the upcoming Spiritual Pilgrim pilgrimage! This is a very special trip - whether it is your first or your fifth trip to Nepal, you will undoubtedly encounter something life changing along the way. As you begin to prepare for this journey there are a few very important pieces of information regarding your passport we wanted to bring to your attention to ensure you are able to join us.

- 1. Nepal requires you to carry a passport that is valid for a minimum of 6 months from your arrival date.
- 2. Visas are required to enter Nepal.
- 3. You must have **two blank pages in your passport for your Nepal visa**. Folks have been turned away in the past for not having enough space in their passport.

MORE INFORMATION ABOUT OBTAINING A VISA

Nepal offers the convenient option of obtaining an "on-arrival" visa at the airport. Costs of visas vary depending on the length of time you are planning to stay in Nepal. You will be required to pay the fee in cash at the airport in Nepal. US Dollars are preferred, but they do accept other foreign currencies as well.

We highly recommend you fill out the visa application in advance and bring two copies of the completed form with you. You can fill out the visa application 14 days prior to your scheduled departure here: https://nepaliport.immigration.gov.np/online

You may also obtain your visa ahead of time by working with a Nepali Embassy or Consulate in your country. Please note the following guidance from the Nepal immigration website:

"If you have obtained visa from Nepalese Diplomatic Missions, then you must enter Nepal within six months from the visa issued date. Your total stay is counted starting from the day you enter into Nepal."
